



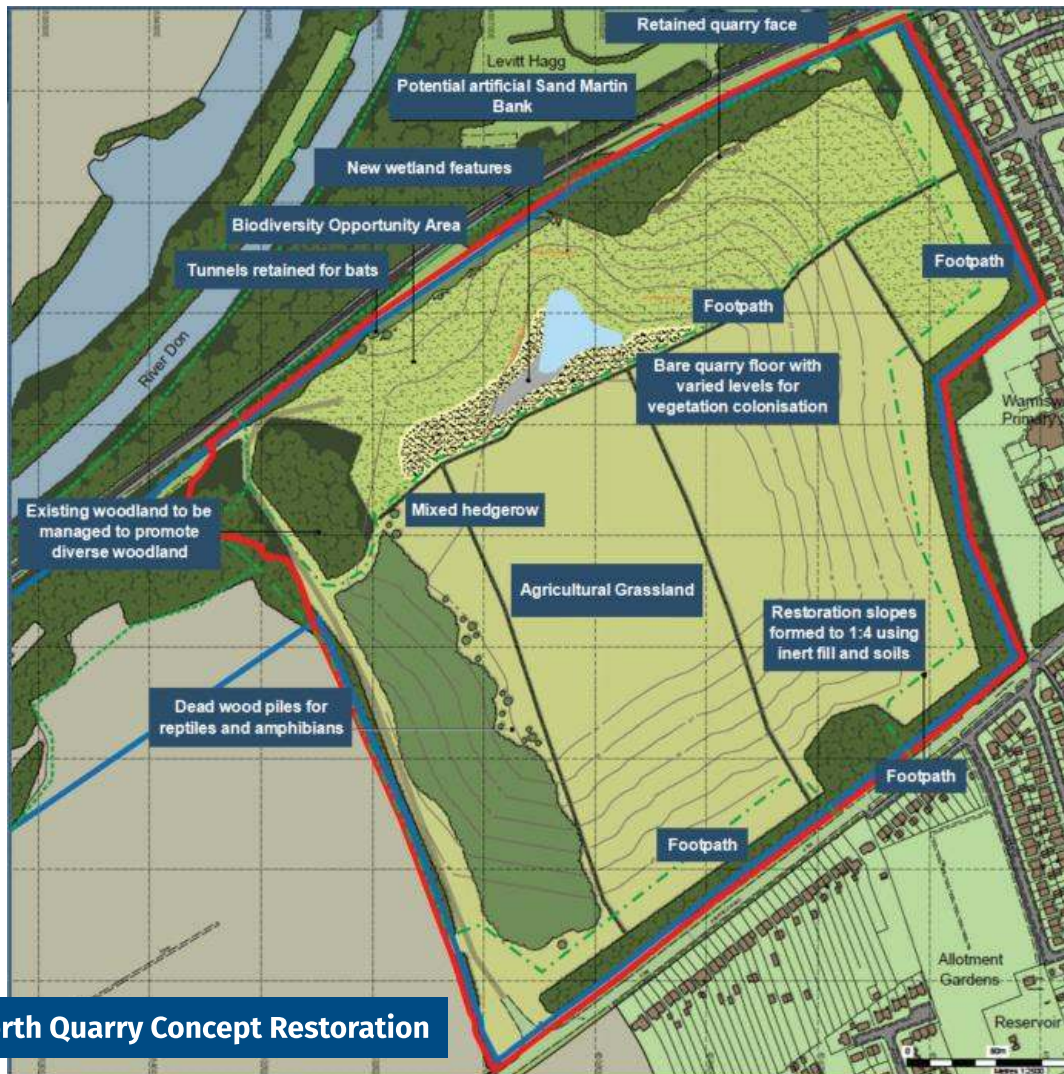
WARMSWORTH QUARRY: SCHEME OF RESTORATION

Sibelco UK Ltd operate Warmsworth Quarry located off Sheffield Road in Warmsworth. Warmsworth Quarry (The Dolomite Quarry) has been operating since the 1930's and supplies dolomite primarily to the glass industry as well as for agricultural use and as crushed aggregates.

Warmsworth Quarry is now nearing the end of its life as a quarry and Sibelco are proposing a scheme of restoration through inert infilling to achieve a valuable end-use for the site. As part of this, the scheme will include a temporary secondary aggregates recycling facility.

A public information event is being held on Monday 24th November 2025 at the Warmsworth Community Hub, Stapleton Road, Warmsworth, Doncaster DN4 9LL.

The event will be open from 4pm-7pm on a 'drop-in' basis in order for local residents to view the restoration scheme, speak with Sibelco and provide feedback.



Warmsworth Quarry Concept Restoration

Sibelco will be required to seek the approval of City of Doncaster Council through the planning process for the restoration scheme as well as the temporary aggregate recycling facility. An Environmental Permit will also be required from the Environment Agency.

It is proposed that the quarry be restored by its existing operational end-date of 2048.

The site provides a unique opportunity for a high quality restoration that takes into account the local community and landscape alongside supporting the circular economy through recycling for its remaining operational life.
