WATER POLICY

(As Agreed by Warmsworth Allotment Holders Association – May 2012)

- 1) A hosepipe may only be used to fill up the new green water butt provided by the council. No hosepipes to be left attached to taps.
- 2) Sprinklers are totally banned on the allotment.
- 3) Once a hosepipe BAN is in place by the Council or Water Authority. No Hose shall be used by anyone, not even for filling up the green water butt.
- 4) A hose cannot be used inside a watering can to water your crops unless it is attached to your water butt.
- 5) No soak-away hoses to be uses unless coupled to your own water butt on your plot.
- 6) When it is Hot try to use water sparingly. Only use water where needed.
- 7) Try to water 1st thing in the morning <u>**OR**</u> later in the evening. We know that this is not always possible, but it is better for your plants.
- 8) Don't waste water, by washing down greenhouses or paths as this is also a waste of water usage (unless it is from your own water butt).
- 9) When we have used our yearly amount of water. The water will be turned off. We can only be supplied with so much water from the council.
- 10) Nobody wants to turn the water off, but unless everyone tries to save water, where they can. <u>This Will Happen</u>.

- 11) A chart will be placed around the allotment so that you will be able to see how much the water usage goes down. This will also be a warning as to when the water will go off for good.
- 12) Once the water is turned off. You will only have the water collected in your water butt. And This Will Be Final.

SO PLEASE TAKE CARE WITH WATER – IT IS A SCARCE, VALUABLE AND COSTLY RESOURCE.
